WINTER SEASON

During the period October to April inclusive we have weekly Pool sessions at **Austin Rawlinson Pool**, Conleach Road, Speke, Liverpool L24 0TR.

Monday National league canoe polo advanced training 8 – 9pm

Tuesdays Novice canoe polo 8 - 9pm

Wednesdays there are two sessions 7-8pm and 8-9pm. First session more for beginners but both are general canoeing sessions when coaching is given. Kayaks, buoyancy aids, paddles, etc; are provided although you may bring you own if you wish. There is a small charge for the pool sessions to cover pool hire. Wednesday pool charges are £4.00 for the one hour session, or £6 for the two hour session. The Monday and Tuesday polo sessions are also £4.00 for the hour.

SUMMER SEASON

During the period May to September inclusive we have weekly paddling and coaching sessions at Merseysport Watersports Centre and Crosby Adventure Centre.
