




# Friends Of Allonby Canoe Club Liverpool

Camping at Saint Francis Xavier's College, use Woolton Hill Road entrance L25 6JA.

Camping is free of charge.

Please camp around the edge of the cricket field near to the social club. Marked in yellow on the map. Please camp within the demarcated area as there will be cricket matches going on over the weekend.

Entrance into the school is via Woolton Hill Road. Follow signs to Xaverians Social club on right, enter a small car park. You can park here or in the overflow car park which is through the double metal gates in the top right hand corner (these will be unlocked all night). Go through them and continue straight along with the college buildings on your left. Overflow parking is in the car park in front of the Lemaitre Building next to chapel.

Campervans, motorhomes and caravans please use the overflow car park.

The campsite will be available from 4:30pm on Friday through until Sunday evening. Although the campsite is well hidden away, we would advise you not to leave any valuables at the campsite as neither FOA nor St Francis Xaviers can take responsibility for any items going missing. There will be people on site during the day on Sat and Sun as the social club will be in use by its members.

The toilets and showers are on the ground floor of the Social Club. The bar will be open on the Fri and Sat nights and the beer prices are very reasonable. **Please do not take your own alcohol into the Social Club building.** The building will be locked and alarmed once the bar closes at around midnight. It will be open again from around 7.00am til 8.00am then again from 12 noon. There will be portaloos near the social club for overnight use.

Water tap is in the corner opposite the chapel.

There are a range of takeaways, shops, restaurants and pubs approx. 1 mile away in Woolton Village. Leave the college via the Woolton Hill Road entrance, turn right then take 3rd exit at roundabout heading right (Church Road). Carry on approx. 1 mile into Woolton Village.

Please clear up your litter and don't light fires, we want to be allowed to come back again next year!

As this is school premises no dogs are allowed.
